Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in Regular Session on Monday, November 23, 2009 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Randy Mills, Commissioners Jim Boatwright, Jon Bonner and Dickie Clary. Commissioner Lewis was absent.

The meeting was called to order and Judge Mills opened with prayer.

There were no public comments.

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Bonner to approve the minutes of October 26, 2009, November 9, 2009, November 12, 2009 and November 13, 2009 Hamilton County Commissioner's Court. The motion carried unanimously.

There were no budget amendments.

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Bonner to approve \$208,822.27 amount of bills submitted for payment. Of that total \$208,822.27 amount \$172,545.44 is for courthouse renovation. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 34 Page 699)

A motion was made by Boatwright and seconded by Bonner to approve the bond of Sheriff Gregg Bewley. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 34 Page 707)

A motion was made by Bonner and seconded by Boatwright to approve the appointment of Net Data Representative Debbie Reynolds to the Local Data Advisory Board for the Texas Computerized Criminal History. The motion carried unanimously.

Judge Mills opened the bid received for the vehicles for the Sheriff's Office. Brumbalow Motors submitted the bid for two units being Dodge Chargers in the amount of \$22,625.00 plus tax and fees.

A motion was made by Boatwright and seconded by Clary to accept the bid received from Brumbalow Motors for the two units (Dodge Chargers) for \$22,625.00 plus tax and fees. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 34 Page 711)

Komatsu's Architecture's Representative Gordon Marchant was present to give an overview of Phase V and Phase VI of the courthouse restoration project. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 34 Page 713)
