Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in Regular Session on Monday, April 12, 2010 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Randy Mills, Commissioners Jim Boatwright, Mike Lewis, Jon Bonner and Dickie Clary.

The meeting was called to order and Judge Mills opened with prayer.

There were no public comments.

A motion was made by Boatwright and seconded by Bonner to approve the minutes of March 22, 2010 Commissioner's Court Meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Lewis and seconded by Clary to approve the budget amendments submitted. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Book 35 Page 659)

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Lewis to approve \$473,826.77 amount of bills submitted; of the total amount of \$473,826.77 a payment of \$362,502.94 is to RBR Construction, Inc. and the remainder of the amount (\$111,323.83) is regular county expenses. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 35 page 645)

A motion was made by Lewis and seconded by Boatwright to approve the Resolution to express sympathy in the death of Hamilton County Sheriff Ryan Craig Isham. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Boatwright and seconded by Bonner to approve the American Institute of Architects (A.I.A.) Agreement with Komatsu Architecture for Phase II Courthouse Restoration. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioners Court Papers Book 35 Page 671)

The court discussed the end of Phase I stating that the Owner's Meeting would be April 21, 2010. At that time the county should have the last punch list. The cupola was discussed and County Auditor Marliessa Clark requested that the court withhold payment until the completion of the cupola had been completed. The court was in agreement to withhold the payment amount of \$44,729.26 until the cupola issue had been resolved.

A motion was made by Boatwright and seconded by Bonner to approve bond renewal for Hamilton County Deputy District Clerk Sandy Layhew. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 35 Page 621)

A motion was made by Boatwright and seconded by Lewis to approve the departmental reports submitted. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 35 Page 698)

A motion was made by Boatwright and seconded by Lewis adjourn. The motion carried unanimously.
