

Hamilton County Commissioner's Court  
Regular Session  
Monday, May 10, 2010  
9:00 A.M.

Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in Regular Session on Monday, May 10, 2010 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Randy Mills, Commissioners Jim Boatwright, Mike Lewis, Jon Bonner and Dickie Clary.

The meeting was called to order and Commissioner Clary opened with prayer.

There were no public comments.

A motion was made by Boatwright and seconded by Bonner to approve the minutes of April 26, 2010 with the typing error corrected the word from mathogen to pathogen. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Lewis to approve the budget amendments submitted. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 35 Page 839)

A motion was made by Lewis and seconded by Clary to approve \$147,644.66 amount of bills submitted for payment. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 35 Page 845)

A motion was made by Boatwright and seconded by Bonner to approve the Proclamation recognizing National Police Week (the week of May 15, 2010). The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 35 Page 858)

Commissioner Lewis announced that the owner's meeting for May had been postponed.

Judge Mills stated that the contractor was checking to see if the asphalt around the courthouse was to be removed before or to remain during the drilling of the geothermal wells.

A motion was made by Lewis and seconded by Bonner to approve Amendment No. 1 to the Texas Community Development Program Contract No. 729097 Texas Department of Rural Affairs (formally Known as Office of Community Affairs) and the County of Hamilton. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 35 Page 859)

During the departmental reports Judge Mills stated that it may not be necessary to run the anaerobic digester program through the county for participation and they may be able to pursue it without county sponsorship.

A motion was made by Boatwright and seconded by Lewis to approve both verbal and written departmental reports. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 35 Page 862)

A motion was made by Boatwright and seconded by Lewis to adjourn. The motion carried unanimously.
