Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in Special Session on Monday, October 4, 2010 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Randy Mills, Commissioners Mike Lewis, Jon Bonner and Dickie Clary. Commissioner Jim Boatwright was absent.

The meeting was called to order.

The purpose of the meeting was to open the bids for subcontractors for Phase II of the Hamilton County Courthouse Restoration. RBR Construction stated that they had received several comments that the companies preparing bids were not given enough time to prepare and RBR requested that Hamilton County grant an extension for receiving bids for Phase II. RBR said that by doing so it is possible that Hamilton County may save some money. RBR had allowed five (5) weeks in Phase I for the businesses to submit their bids and in Phase II had only allowed three (3) weeks therefore there were still several bills not completed in time for submission.

After a discussion a motion was made by Clary seconded by Bonner to extend the bid deadline for Phase II until October 19, 2010, opening the bids on October 21, 2010 and receiving the Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) on October 25, 2010. Judge Mills informed RBR that County Auditor Marliessa Clark needed to be an integral part of the GMP.

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Bonner to adjourn. The motion carried unanimously.
