Regular Session
Monday, December 13, 2010
9:00 A.M.

Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in Regular Session on Monday, December 13, 2010 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Randy Mills, Commissioners Jim Boatwright, Mike Lewis, Jon Bonner and Dickie Clary.

The meeting was called to order and Judge Mills opened with prayer.

County Clerk Debbie Rudolph informed the court that she had just returned from the 56th Annual Bureau of Vital Statistics Conference – Austin and had received the Five Star Award-Recognized for her office.

A motion was made by Boatwright and seconded by Clary to approve the minutes of November 22, 2010 and December 1, 2010 Commissioner's Court Meetings. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Lewis and seconded by Bonner to approve the following budget amendments: (1) Sheriff's Office from Health Insurance to Unemployment Insurance and (2) Precinct Two from Capital Equipment to Unemployment. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Book 38 Page 170)

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Bonner to approve \$172,510.82 amount of bills submitted for payment. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Book 38 Page 174)

Judge Mills stated that they were cleaning out the floors of the courthouse to prepare for construction and Commissioner Lewis stated that they were waiting on shop drawings to begin. Lewis also stated that they would begin the electrical, plumbing and the demolition.

A motion was made by Lewis and seconded by Bonner to approve the appointment of Shawna Galindo, Kimi Philips and Bea Coble to the Hamilton County Child Protective Service Board. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Boatwright to approve the deputation for Hamilton County Deputy Sheriffs Timothy John Fanning, Jr. Rondy Frank, Daniel Rathburn, Rick Berry and Sam Gladney. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Book 38 Page 189)

A motion was made by Bonner and seconded by Clary to approve bonds for Hamilton County Deputy Sheriffs Timothy John Fanning, Jr. Rondy Frank, Daniel Rathburn, Rick Berry, Sam Gladney, Hamilton County Justice of the Peace, Precinct Three Laurie Brous Jackson, Hamilton County Sheriff Gregg Bewley and Hamilton County Treasurer Debbie Eoff. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 38 Page 189)

A motion was made by Lewis and seconded by Bonner to table approval of the contract between Net Data and Hamilton County to electronically file citations in the County and provided by the Texas Department of Public Safety to Hamilton County Justice of the Peace Courts. The court withdrew their motion, no action taken.

A motion was made Boatwright and seconded by Bonner to place a burn ban on Hamilton County for ninety days. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Boatwright and seconded by Bonner to authorize Hamilton County Auditor to request bids for motor fuel for Hamilton County Sheriff's

Office, Commissioners Precincts and Constable. Commissioner Lewis stated that his dyed diesel tank was 500 gallons not 1000 gallons and Commissioner Clary stated that his dyed diesel tank was a 1000 gallons not 500 gallons. Correction noted. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Boatwright and seconded by Lewis to approve the department reports submitted. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 38 Page 223)

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Boatwright to adjourn. The motion carried unanimously.
