Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in Regular Session on Monday, December 27, 2010 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Randy Mills, Commissioners Jim Boatwright, Mike Lewis, Jon Bonner and Dickie Clary.

Judge Mills called the meeting to order and Commissioner Clary opened with prayer.

There were no public comments.

Judge Mills read a proclamation recognizing Hamilton County Commissioner Mike Lewis for his service to Hamilton County and also presented him a service plaque.

Commissioner Lewis thanked the court, his county precinct hands and other county officials and county employees.

A motion was made by Lewis and seconded by Boatwright to approve the minutes of December 13, 2010. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Bonner and seconded by Clary to approve the budget amendment for the Sheriff transferring \$1500.00 from Equipment Repair and Maintenance to Vehicle Repair and Maintenance. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 38 Page 271)

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Boatwright to approve \$71,690.95 amount of bills submitted for payment; of the total amount \$45,097.58 amount for courthouse restoration. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 38 Page 273)

Commissioner Lewis stated that the plumbers and electricians were working on the courthouse. RBR Construction's Pete Gaduary was waiting for shop drawings to come in.

A motion was made by Lewis and seconded by Bonner to approve departmental reports. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 38 Page 285)

A motion was made by Lewis and seconded by Bonner to adjourn. The motion carried unanimously.
