Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in Regular Session on Monday, March 14, 2011 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Randy Mills, Commissioners Jim Boatwright, Mark Tafel, Jon Bonner and Dickie Clary.

The meeting was called to order and Judge Mills opened with prayer.

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Boatwright to approve the minutes of February 28, 2011 Commissioner's Court. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Boatwright and seconded by Bonner to approve the budget amendments (One being intergovernmental cleaning up issues from the bank reconciliation and two being RBR Construction). The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 38 Page 672)

Approving the bills was skipped until the court reconvenes at 1:00 P.M.

A motion was made by Bonner and seconded by Clary to approve the Hamilton County Burn Ban until April 11, 2011. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 38 Page 675)

Judge Mills announced during construction at the courthouse that it was discovered that the vault door of the Justice of the Peace, Precinct One originally opens into the hallway. The vault door will be placed in the hallway.

A motion was made by Tafel and seconded by Bonner to approve the Public Participation Form for Hamilton County Commissioner's Court with a change in the wording as follows:

Commissioner Tafel presented his Open Meetings Training Signature Sheet Only for Court's signatures. Judge Mills stated that this would be added to the departmental reports for approval. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 38 Page 715)

A motion was made by Boatwright and seconded by Bonner to approve the departmental reports. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 38 Page 678)

The court reconvened at 1:37 P.M. for the purpose of approving the bills.

A motion was made by Boatwright and seconded by Clary to approve \$384,758.36 amount of bills submitted for payment. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 38 Page 716)

A motion was made by Boatwright and seconded by Clary to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried unanimously.
