Special Session

Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in a Special Session on Monday, November 21, 2011 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Randy Mills, Commissioners Jim Boatwright, Mark Tafel, Jon Bonner and Dickie Clary.

The meeting was called to order.

County Clerk Debbie Rudolph presented to the court the information to canvass the votes for the Local Option and Constitutional Amendment Election for November 8, 2011. The local option issue for the City of Hamilton jurisdiction to sell all alcoholic beverages including mixed beverages passed with a vote of 395 in favor and 269 against. The court reviewed the results. A motion was made by Boatwright and seconded by Clary to approve the canvass for the Local Option and Constitutional Amendment.

A motion was made by Mills and seconded by Bonner to approve Michael Van enter to restore the vault door and to consider using the vault door from the courthouse annex. If the door from the second floor, district clerk's office could be utilized the court would like for it to be considered. The motion carried by a majority vote with Mills, Bonner and Tafel voting in favor; Boatwright and Clary voting against. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Book 41 Page 713)

A motion was made by Mills and seconded by Bonner to ratify Hamilton County Judge's letter dated April 14, 2011 authorizing Hamilton County Commissioner Precinct Two Mark Tafel, a concealed handgun license holder, to carry a concealed handgun in Hamilton County Commissioner's Court. Mills, Tafel and Bonner voted for and Boatwright and Clary voted against the ratification of the letter dated April 14, 2011 written by Judge Mills. The issue carried by a majority vote. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Book 41 Page 712 and 714)

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Tafel to adjourn. The meeting adjourned.
