

Hamilton County Commissioner's Court  
Workshop-Courthouse Move

Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in a workshop on Monday, January 30, 2012 at 8:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Randy Mills, Commissioners Jim Boatwright, Jon Bonner and Dickie Clary. Commissioner Mark Tafel was absent.

The court met to give instructions for the move and cautioned us to be very careful not to damage the woodwork and the floors. The court advised that the padded curtains be hung in the elevators to protect the finish on the elevators.

Juvenile Probation Officer Kyle Baker requested that a door be cut between offices because there was an issue of confidentiality. Commissioner Clary stated that he was not interested in cutting a hole in the wall and Judge Mills added that it would require another change order to install a door between the offices. The court decided to make the outer office on the third floor a storage area therefore that would eliminate the need for the door to be installed and moved Maintenance Supervisor Carl Taylor to the basement.

The Texas Historical Commission stated the cabinets in the Tax Assessor Collector's office and the Justice of the Peace, Precinct One's office is ADA non compliant and that there will need to be adjustments made to each of them.

The court recessed until 11:30 A.M. The court reconvened until Tuesday, January 31, 2012 at 8:00 A.M. The court reconvened at 8:15 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Randy Mills, Commissioners Jim Boatwright, Jon Bonner and Dickie Clary. Commissioner Mark Tafel was absent.

The telephones will be on in the courthouse on Friday, February 13, 2012. Pete Gadoury is inquiring into the door locks. A Certificate of Occupancy needs to be sent to Texas New Mexico Power for the Smart Program.

Commissioner Clary requested Collin Melton for a proposal on the courthouse lawn. Clary also requested that there was a need for an office for the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality Inspection Officer.

Commissioner Boatwright asked about the flag on cupola and Judge Mills responded that it would be up on Monday morning.

The court recessed until 3:00 P.M. Reconvening at 3:00 P.M. the court had no business a motion was made by Bonner and seconded by Clary to adjourn. The motion carried.
