Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in a Special Session-Policy Workshop, Wednesday, February 23, 2012 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Randy Mills, Commissioners Jim Boatwright, Mark Tafel, Jon Bonner and Dickie Clary.

The meeting was called to order by Judge Mills and turned it over to Commissioner Clary.

Commissioner Clary stated that he had concerns about having policies that we did not adhere to then we needed to remove them from the policy.

Judge Mills read an Ag Opinion JC-0214 to the court. Mills continued stating that once the court sets the county budget for the elected officer it is a discretionary position. The court may not micro manage the elected officials.

The judge also stated that according to the same opinion the specifications released for a bid should be approved by the commissioner's court.

After much discussion between court members the court reviewed the policy.
