Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in Regular Session on Monday, June 11, 2012 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Randy Mills, Commissioners Jim Boatwright, Jon Bonner and Dickie Clary. Commissioner Mark Tafel was absent.

The meeting was called to order and Judge Mills opened with prayer.

Damon Chumney asked if the Hamilton County Appraisal District could get in some kind of trouble for the mistake the Chief Appraiser made. It should not go unnoticed.

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Boatwright to approve the following budget amendments: Hamilton County Sheriff's Office from Deputy 4 (Four) to Overtime, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office from Dispatcher/Jailer Two to Overtime, Non-departmental from Autopsy to Redistricting Fee, Courthouse from Non Capital to General Repairs Annex, Hamilton County Sheriff's Office from Gas to Prisoner Transport Housing, County Treasurer from Equipment Repair to Schools and Conferences, Hamilton County Precinct One from Fuel to Electricity, and County Clerk from Equipment Repair and Maintenance to Election Expense. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Boatwright to approve the following consent agenda:
