Hamilton County Commissioners Court met in a Special Session on Friday, January 18, 2013 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Randy Mills, Commissioners Johnny Wagner, Mark Tafel, Lloyd Huggins and Dickie Clary.

The meeting was called to order.

The purpose of the meeting was to considering approving funding for the purchase of additional band width for the courthouse.

The court discussed taking the money from the courthouse security fund. Judge James Lively explained to the court that the band width issue was a problem that was not going away because the state is mandating more and more filings electronically.

The court wanted a five (5) gig for a cost of \$953.00 per month instead of a ten (10) gig but state in the contract that Hamilton County has the option to change to a ten (10) gig without incurring a monthly penalty.

A motion was made by Tafel and seconded by Wagner to approve the Product and Service Agreement between Hamilton County and Century Link Sales Solutions, Inc. for 5 mbps Enhanced Ethernet Service. The motion carried by a majority vote of four. Judge Mills abstained. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 45 Page 256)
