Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in Regular Session on Monday, June 24, 2013 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Randy Mills, Commissioners Johnny Wagner, Mark Tafel, Lloyd Huggins and Dickie Clary.

The meeting was called to order and Tafel opened with prayer.

There were no public comments.

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Huggins to approve the following budget amendments: Precinct Two from Auto and Equipment Liability to Road Materials and Supplies, District Court from Transcript to Other Indigent, Court Appointed Attorney and Jury; Non-Departmental from Professional Services to Professional Services; Sheriff's Office from Investigation to Equipment Repair, Justice of the Peace, Precinct Three from Supplies to Telephone, Jail from Uniforms to Equipment Repair and County Jail from Schools and Conferences to Janitorial Supplies. The motion carried by a majority vote. Wagner, Tafel, Huggins and Clary voted for and Mills abstained. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 46 Page 245)

A motion was made by Huggins and seconded by Clary to approve the minutes of June 10, 2013 Commissioner's Court Meeting. The motion carried by a majority vote. Wagner, Tafel, Huggins and Clary voted for and Mills abstained.

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Tafel to approve the departmental reports submitted. The motion carried by a majority vote. Wagner, Tafel, Huggins and Clary voted for and Mills abstained. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 46 Page 269)

A motion was made by Tafel to approve \$915.52 Fleet Safety Equipment for Precinct Two billing. The motion dies for lack of a second.

A motion was made by Tafel and seconded by Wagner to approve the bills submitted in the amount of \$32,163.41. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 46 Page 260)

A presentation of the activity report was presented by Texas A&M AgriLife Representative Donald Kelm highlighting the previous year's events.

Leon River Watershed Coordinator Mike Marshall was present to introduce himself to the court and to make himself available to the county should the court have any questions pertaining to the Leon River Watershed Protection Plan.

A motion was made by Tafel and seconded by Huggins to approve Hamilton County Precinct 3 personnel and equipment to enter private property for road drainage purposes at Leon New property on

County Road 217 and Roline Chaney property on County Road 242. The motion carried by a majority vote. Wagner, Tafel, Huggins and Clary voted for and Mills abstained.

A motion was made by Wagner and seconded by Mills to approve the deputation for Hamilton County Deputy Sheriff Chance A. Logan. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 46 Page 293)

A motion was made by Wagner and seconded by Huggins to approve the bond for Hamilton County Assistant Auditor Marliessa Clark and Hamilton County Deputy Sheriff Chance A. Logan. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 46 Page 287)

A motion was made by Mills and seconded by Clary to approve the county's participation in the County Hog Abatement Matching Program (CHAMP) Grant 2014. The one year grant program will address a bounty program, public education and enhance our trapper program. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 46 Page 282)

There were no future agenda items.

There was no budget workshop.

A motion was made by Tafel and seconded by Huggins to adjourn. The motion carried by a majority vote. Wagner, Tafel, Huggins and Clary voted for and Mills abstained.
