Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in a Special Session on Monday, August 05, 2013 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Randy Mills, Commissioners Johnny Wagner, Mark Tafel, Lloyd Huggins and Dickie Clary.

The court began with the first item of business the Hamilton County Law Enforcement Contract discussing the letter received from the City of Hamilton stating that they did not want to include the administrative assistant in the calculation for the city's cost. They would like for it to be calculated on the number of deputies as opposed to the number of employees in the Sheriff's budget. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 46 Page 685)

The city also requested that the Sheriff assist with the animal control services.

The court discussed the city's request and came to a decision. Huggins made a motion which was seconded by Clary to base the calculations of the city's contract upon the number of deputies and not on the number of employees and including the animal control services to remain the same and that such would be handled by the city animal control officer. The motion passed by a majority vote with Wagner, Tafel, Huggins and Clary voting for and Mills abstaining.

The court then went into a budget workshop and discussed the district attorney's budget which they decided to leave the \$5000.00 in the investigation line item.

The court also discussed raises for the jailers with no current conclusion.

The item of longevity pay was discussed for county employees with no determination made. Judge Mills presented a resolution he had received from Jack County for the court to review. (Recorded in Commissioners Court Book 46 Page 692)

A motion was made by Tafel and seconded by Huggins to adjourn. The motion passed by a majority vote with Wagner, Tafel, Huggins and Clary voting for and Mills abstaining.
