Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in Budget Workshop on Monday, September 16, 2013 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Randy Mills, Commissioners Johnny Wagner, Mark Tafel and Dickie Clary. Commissioner Lloyd Huggins was absent.

The budget workshop was called to order.

The court reviewed the Resolution Authorizing Hamilton County Longevity Increment Policy Fiscal Year 2013-2014 and made the following changes to the document:

- 3. Service time shall be calculated as of October 1, 2013
4. All hourly paid Hamilton County Employees are eligible to participate in this increment if employed by Hamilton County on or before October 1, 2013 and currently in employment on the date when longevity increment is paid.
