Hamilton County Commissioners Court met in Regular Session on Tuesday, November 12, 2013 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Randy Mills, Commissioners Johnny Wagner, Lloyd Huggins and Dickie Clary. Commissioner Mark Tafel was absent.

The meeting was called to order and Wagner opened with prayer.

There were no public comments.

Canvassing the votes for the November 5, 2013 Constitutional Amendment Election will be held on Wednesday, November 13, 2013 at 9:00 A.M.

There were no budget amendments.

A motion was made by Huggins and seconded by Clary to approve the Minutes of 10-28-2013 Commissioners Court Meeting with the correction replacing Lasater with Ricky Mauney with 641 votes. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Wagner and seconded by Clary to approve the departmental reports submitted. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 47 Page 676)

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Huggins to approve the bills submitted for payment in the amount of \$144,361.88. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 47 Page 666)

Clary requested that the report from the County Treasurer include when the accounts are closed, dates reconciled, progress report on accounts and anticipated completion date for the December 1st deadline for the longevity pay for the employees if there is \$1 million dollars in the account.

Eoff responded that she was currently working on August and that it looked like they were on target assuming nothing unexpectedly came up.

A motion was made by Mills and seconded by Wagner to approve the bond renewals for Hamilton County Sheriff Gregg Bewley, Hamilton County Deputy Kiesha Bagwell and Hamilton County Deputy Treasurer Katie Thompson.
