Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in Regular Session on Monday, February 24, 2014 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Randy Mills, Commissioners Johnny Wagner, Lloyd Huggins and Dickie Clary. Commissioner Mark Tafel was absent.

There were no public comments.

A motion was made by Huggins and seconded by Clary to approve the out of state travel for two deputies to Georgia. The registration fees of \$1000.00 are complimentary and the only costs that will be incurred for this training will be fuel, lodging and food. The motion carried unanimously.

There were no budget amendments.

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Huggins to approve the following consent agenda:

- B. Approve Department Reports (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 48 Page 225)
- C. Approve bills submitted for payment \$59,585.87 (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 48 Page 215)

The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Wagner to approve the donation of approximately 1000 cubic yards of road material to be used for resurfacing from Paul and Marion Rogers for use on CR 411 which is approximately six tenths of a mile. The motion carried unanimously.

County Treasurer Eoff stated that all accounts were reconciled except for one being the treasurer's account. County Auditor Marliessa Clark stated that the County Treasurer was working on reconciliation of that account and currently at October 2013. Clary asked if this item need to remain as an agenda item and the auditor and treasure both confirmed that it should remain until this was completed.

There were no future agenda items.

A motion was made by Wagner and seconded by Huggins to adjourn. The motion carried unanimously.
