Special Session Monday, August 18, 2014 9:00 A.M.



Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in a Special Session on Monday, August 18, 2014 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Randy Mills, Commissioners Johnny Wagner, Mark Tafel, Lloyd Huggins and Dickie Clary.

Mills called the public hearing to order and all members of the court were present.

Public comments were made by Mike Bosse, Damon Chumney and Richard Layne.

Mike Bosse commented on Precinct Two asking what makes his job more important than the other three precincts that he makes \$2200.00 more than the other commissioners? Precinct Two salary needs to return to what the other three precincts make.

Damon Chumney went through the entire budget page by page commenting on numerous items. Chumney focused on the salary increases which he was against.

Richard Layne stated that his problem with the budget is that the hourly employees were to get a raise and then the elected officials were added. He would like to see that the elected officials be reduced from a three percent increase to a one and a half percent increase.

Bob Self stated that he would like to see the court have their meetings at night time to allow for the public to attend.

Mills closed the public hearing after all comments and discussion had been heard.

Mills opened the regular meeting and the full court was still present.

The court called for an executive session to discuss contemplated litigation regarding request by Hamilton County Official for reimbursement fees incurred. The court closed the executive session and took a short recess.

Mills called the court back into its regular session.

Tafel read to the court that if the court found an official which had acted in good faith and presented to the court Judge Mills letter giving Tafel permission to carry his weapon. This was acting in good faith. No action taken by the court.

A motion was made by Clary and seconded by Huggins to adjourn. The meeting adjourned. The motion carried unanimously.
