Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in a Special Session on Thursday, February 26, 2015 at 10:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Mark Tynes, Commissioners Keith Allen Curry, Lloyd Huggins, and Dickie Clary. Commissioner Johnny Wagner was absent.

The meeting was called to order.

A motion was made by Huggins and seconded by Curry to approve the budget amendments as follows: County Jail from Inmate Medical to Employee Medical, County Judge from Non-Capital to Schools and Conferences and from Supplies & Stationery to Emergency Management, and Juvenile Court from Court Costs to Other Indigent Expense. A motion was made by Huggins and seconded by Clary to approve the bills for payment in the amount of \$196, 160.63. The motion carried unanimously.
