Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in a Special Session on Tuesday, April 21, 2015 at 2:00 P.M. with the following members present: County Judge Mark Tynes, Commissioners Johnny Wagner and Keith Allen Curry. Commissioners Lloyd Huggins and Dickie Clary were absent.

Tynes called the meeting to order and established that there was a quorum present.

Algae Busters' Owner Scotty Bell gave a presentation about his treatment stating that he created this product in 1994 and he is the sole source of this treatment product. He explained that you apply the product to the wall and that moisture causes it to reactivate and kills the algae. His product works on all surfaces. It takes twenty-two (22) seconds to kill the algae. Uniform cleaning penetrates the surface, algae decays and falls off the wall for two years. Most of the time one application kills the algae but in certain areas it could take two applications. The process should start at the cap stone and works its way down.

Mr. Bell explained that he has done a lot of buildings in Ft. Worth and most of the TCU campus.

The court requested that the proposal include not only the cost, but addresses bonding and proof of approval from the Texas Historical Commission.

A motion was made by Wagner and seconded by Curry to adjourn. The motion carried unanimously.
