

**Hamilton County Commissioner's Court**

Regular Session  
Tuesday, May 26, 2015  
9:00 A.M.



Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in Regular Session on Tuesday, May 26, 2015 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Mark Tynes, Commissioners Johnny Wagner, Keith Allen Curry and Lloyd Huggins. Commissioner Dickie Clary was on vacation.

Tynes called the meeting to order and established that there was a quorum present.

Huggins opened with prayer and Robert Jackson led the pledges.

Judge Tynes thanked Sheriff Bewley, Chief Deputy Kenneth Lovell, Commissioner Keith Allen Curry, the emergency management services who responded to the bad weather off of FM 932 and CR 432.

A motion was made by Huggins and seconded by Curry to approve the following budget amendments: Sheriff from Investigations to Uniforms, Jail from Janitorial to Schools and Conferences, Jail from Equipment Rental to Prisoner Transport/Housing, and Justice of the Peace, Pct. One, from Supplies and Stationery to Travel. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers book 51 Page 879)

A motion was made by Wagner and seconded by Curry to approve the following consent agenda:

- C. Approve Bills Submitted for Payment-\$46,808.12 (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 51 Page 888)

The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Wagner and seconded by Huggins to accept the bank depository bid submitted from Mills County State Bank. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers book 52 Page 1)

Tynes is still waiting for one proposal from Brazos Masonry regarding the algae on the courthouse.

A motion was made by Huggins and seconded by Wagner to approve the bond for Deputy Justice of the Peace, Precinct One, Joy Stevens. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 52 Page 16)

A motion was made by Wagner and seconded by Curry to reject the initial offer from Wyatt Construction Company dated July 2014 and authorize Allison Bass to submit the in-kind counter settlement as defined in the documentation presented to the court. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 52 Page 20)

Huggins informed the court that he would be going out for bids in Precinct Three for a used motor grader.
