

Hamilton County Commissioner's Court

Special Called Session
Monday, November 16, 2015
9:00 A.M.



Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in a Special Called Session on Monday, November 16, 2015 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Mark Tynes, Commissioners Johnny Wagner, Lloyd Huggins and Dickie Clary. Commissioner Keith Allen Curry was absent.

Tynes called the meeting to order and established that a quorum was present.

The court saw no problem with the request made by Johnny Clepper to include coffee, cookies and Christmas carols during the assembly of the Nativity Scene on Saturday, November 28, 2015 at 2:00 P.M.

A motion was made by Wagner and seconded by Huggins to approve the canvass for the Constitutional Amendment Election conducted on November 3, 2015. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 53 Page 273)

The court reviewed the Historic Hamilton County Courthouse Building and Use Policy and ideals for modifications to the building use policy that Huggins presented to the court. After a brief discussion the court added these two points of interest for consideration:

- 1. The event by sponsored by an elected official and
2. Shall secure and have a licensed peace officer present at the event acting as a security officer.

Changes discussed to the existing policy:

- 11. All group (s) or individual (s) who are approved to use the property shall be required to give a deposit of \$1,000.00 prior to use,
13. Common areas are defined as hallways, portico, lawn and parking lot; deleting the words Commissioners Courtroom, Jury Room, Conference/Witness rooms

The court decided to place this item on the next commissioner's court agenda to allow time for the members to think about the policy and the suggested changes.

A motion was made by Huggins and seconded by Wagner to adjourn. The motion carried unanimously.
