Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in Regular Session on Tuesday, August 09, 2016 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Mark Tynes, Commissioners Johnny Wagner, Keith Allen Curry, Lloyd Huggins and Dickie Clary.

Tynes called the meeting to order followed by Clary's invocation and Tynes leading the pledges.

Tynes stated to Jim Kenton during public comments that if the court did implement the burn ban that the order would be the same order used last year noting the exceptions of the prescribed burn bans.

Damon Chumney spoke stating that he knew that there was a lot of emphasis on law enforcement and that it had been run like Obama. The jail cannot pass inspection because they were not doing their jobs. The person who did not do his job and walked away from the shipwreck has been rewarded by having him serve as a reserve deputy.

A motion was made by Wagner and seconded by Curry to approve the appointment of Presiding Judge David Courtney and Alternate Presiding Judge Judy Jackson of the Central Counting Station. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Wagner and seconded by Curry to approve the appointment of Debbie Rudolph, Central Counting Station Manager, Kiesha Bagwell, Tabulation Supervisor and Mashell Thompson, Assistant Tabulation Supervisor. The motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Huggins and seconded by Clary to approve the change of the polling location from the Carlton Volunteer Fire Department to the Carlton Baptist Church, Carlton, Election Precinct 15. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 55 Page 181)

A motion was made by Huggins and seconded by Clary to approve the change of the polling locations for the Republican Party for the Primary Elections from First Community Bank to the Hico Community Center for Hico, Precinct 7. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 55 Page 183)

A motion was made by Huggins and seconded by Clary to order the County Clerk to conduct the November 8, 2016 General Election. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 55 Page 184)

A motion was made by Wagner and seconded by Curry to implement the Hamilton County Burn Ban. The motion carried unanimously. (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 55 Page 188)

There were no future agenda items.

The court took a brief recess and reconvened into a budget workshop. After a short review of the budget Clary made a motion to adjourn and Huggins seconded. The motion carried unanimously.
