

**NOTICE OF 2017 TAX YEAR
PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX RATE FOR
HAMILTON COUNTY, TEXAS**

A tax rate of .5605 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of Hamilton County, Texas.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$.5605 per \$100
PRECEEDING YEARS TAX RATE	\$.5605 per \$100
EFFECTIVE TAX RATE	\$.5572 per \$100
ROLLBACK TAX RATE	\$.6018 per \$100

The effective tax rate is the total tax rate needed to raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Hamilton County, Texas from the same properties in both the 2016 tax year and the 2017 tax year.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE ABOVE RATES CAN BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS:

$$\text{Property Tax Amount} = (\text{rate}) \times (\text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$$
